



### **Rome's Ronan Vibert Joins '1066'**

Ronan Vibert takes on the role of Sweyn, the troublesome elder brother of Mark Lester's King Harold II in the forthcoming epic '1066'. RADA trained Vibert made his screen debut in 1986. He has appeared in Cadfael, alongside Sir Derek Jacobi and as Lord Wilmot 'Mottie' Pershaw in the excellent television adaptation of P.G. Wodehouse's Jeeves and Wooster with Stephen Fry and Hugh Laurie.

It was his intense and malevolent portrayal of Maximilien Robespierre in the BBC adaptation of The Scarlet Pimpernel starring Richard E Grant that showed the true depth of his acting talent. He also appeared in the Oscar winning Roman Polanski drama The Pianist and as Lepidus in The BBC and HBO epic Rome.
